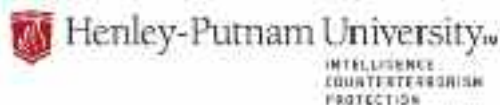

- Former Secret Service agents assigned to the “Presidential Protection Division” teach Advanced Executive Protection.
- The course on Elicitation and Debriefing is currently taught by an individual who practices “interviewing and interrogation techniques” daily for a public agency.
